

Accidents/Incidents Disclaimer

If the student is involved in any kind of accident or incident on campus, clinical laboratory, shop, teaching laboratory, externship/internship or clinical site; the instructor and/or site supervisor must be notified immediately.

College procedures will be followed with respect to Incident and Accident reports including post-accident drug testing. A copy of all such reports will be placed in the students file.

Students are expected to know and follow all policies and procedures in the clinical lab, shop and teaching laboratory areas with regard to OSHA standards and lab or shop safety rules.

If a student is injured, he or she may be treated by his or her own private physician, medical clinic or in the hospital emergency room. The student is responsible for seeking treatment, filing personal insurance and all costs associated with injury accidents.

Since accidents are preventable, the following rules have been established:

- A post- accident drug test must be performed within 24 hours from time of incident
- An incident or accident report form must be completed
- Exposure incidents will be tracked through the Human Resources Department
- Students must also follow site procedures and guidelines for exposure incidents
