Such bodies include, but are not limited to: Oklahoma State Board of Dentistry, Oklahoma State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering, Oklahoma Department of Labor, National Association of Legal Assistants, National Certification Board Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork, American Academy of Professional Coders, The National Board of Surgical Technology and Surgical Assisting, Automotive Service Excellence, American Association of Medical Assistants, and the Dental Assisting National Board. Prospective students are responsible for contacting these regulatory bodies with any questions concerning eligibility or approvals and applicable laws.		
Physical limitations and handicaps	Students with physical limitations or handicaps that interfere with job performance-or limit their ability to perform certain tasks-may not be eligible for certain allied health professions.		
Grievance Procedure	The College has a grievance procedure in place to provide an opportunity to resolve student concerns as quickly as possible.
