

At Community Care College, we remain steadfast in our commitment to the highest standards of education, integrity, and transparency. In keeping with that commitment, we are writing to inform you of a recent update regarding our accreditation status.

On October 16, 2025, the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (ACCSC) has placed Community Care College on *Warning* status. This designation is part of the Commission's regular oversight and review process and does not revoke or remove the College's accreditation.

The ACCSC's decision identifies the following areas for improvement:

- 1. Demonstrating successful student achievement and reporting acceptable rates of student graduation and graduate employment in the career fields for which the College provides education.
- 2. Verifying that the College supports student achievement rates through accurate records and documentation of initial graduate employment.
- 3. Providing additional information regarding the College's *Probationary* status with the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP) for the Surgical Technology program.
